Reflection of Life

Evelyn Lee Beals was born on October 27, 1933, in Delhi, Louisiana, to the late Herbert Lee Sr. and Stella Clay Lee. She was the second of five children, raised in a loving, Christian home that laid the foundation for her lifelong faith and devotion to service.

At the age of 14, Evelyn accepted Christ and became a member of Mount Moriah Baptist Church in Epps, Louisiana, under the leadership of Reverend Frank Wallace, where she faithfully served as an usher.

Later in life, she married Allen Beals Sr., who preceded her in death. She continued to build a life centered on faith, family, and community.

Evelyn's commitment to her faith was evident in her tireless service. She taught Vacation Bible School in the Methodist Church and attended the Louisiana State Baptist Convention, where she received training for her role on the usher board. She served as an instructor for the School of Ushering and the Congress Christian Education and was active in various church auxiliaries and community organizations.

Professionally, Evelyn worked for 13 years at the Delhi Boat Manufacturing Plant. After its closure, she relocated to Las Vegas, Nevada, where she was employed at the MGM Grand Hotel until her retirement. In Las Vegas, she became a member of Grace Immanuel Baptist Church under Pastor Sylvester Parks, serving as President of the Usher Board for many years. Her leadership extended beyond her church as she also served as President of

the City-Wide Usher Board Association, which gave her the opportunity to attend both state and national usher conventions. She loved sharing stories of her travels across the United States and even Canada, particularly with the children in her life. Evelyn's journey of service did not end with retirement or age, it was a lifelong calling. She continued her faithful work on the Usher Board at Grace Immanuel Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Willie C. Wheaton, where she served diligently until her health began to decline. Her presence at the church doors—welcoming with a warm smile and a humble spirit—left a lasting impression on generations of members.

Above all, Evelyn was a devoted mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother who poured love into her family. Her warm spirit, unwavering faith, and servant's heart touched the lives of many. In her 91 years, Evelyn Lee Beals showed us what it means to live with purpose. She taught us that faith is not just something we believe—it's something we do.

Evelyn was preceded in death by her parents, Herbert and Stella Lee; her beloved husband, Allen Beals Sr.; her sons, Clayton Lewis Beals and Graylin Beals; her sisters, Mattie Lee, Ethel Henderson, and Edna Leeks; and her brother, Herbert Lee Jr.

She leaves to cherish her memory: two daughters, Rachelle Owens (Delhi, LA) and Janice Johnson (Las Vegas, NV); two sons, Van Beals (Val) of Las Vegas, NV, and Allen Beals of Neosho, MO; thirteen grandchildren, thirty great-grandchildren, and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. Her legacy of love, faith, and service will live on in all who knew her.
