George W. Spruce was born on September 3, 1940, in Fairfield, Alabama, to Thomas Spruce and Mary Frances Spruce. In 1947, the family moved to Los Angeles, California. George attended Lincoln Elementary School, Willowbrook Jr. High School, and graduated from Centennial High School in Compton, California, in 1958.

After graduating, George joined the United States Army and served his country with honor. He later married Shirley Bee Wagnor (who preceded him in death), and together they had three children: George Terry Spruce, Dolly Lynette Spruce, and Andre Eugene Spruce, all of California. George also had four stepchildren: Norman, Gary, Lyn, and Denise from that marriage.

In 1975, George rekindled a relationship with Marva Jean, and on August 8, 1981, they were united in marriage. Through this union, George gained five bonus children: Carl Hall Jr., Vincent Hall, Dennis "Keith" Hall, Keshia Hall, and LaTonya Hall.

George had a lifelong love for music, electronics, fishing, and motorcycle riding. He enjoyed classic cars, especially Mustangs and Cadillacs. He spent many cherished years camping with his family and his longtime friend, John "DAP" Golden. George was a devoted member of South Side Christian Church, where he served as a deacon and had the honor of baptizing four of

For more than 30 years, George built a strong career as a heavy-duty truck driver with G&G Produce. After retiring, he and his wife relocated from Los Angeles, California, to Las Vegas, Nevada.

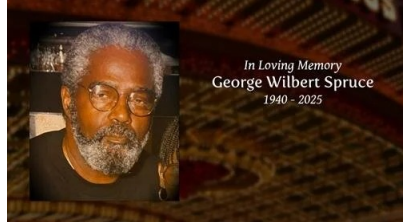
