He started his education in Beaumont, Texas at West Moreland Grade School, but later moved to Oakland, California, where he completed his education.

He then moved back to Texas, where he married and to that union he had three sons and one daughter. His daughter died at a month old. Henry moved back to Los Angeles, CA and started working in the fiberglass industry. He owned his business, H & L Fiberglass, here in Las Vegas. Henry was a guitarist from the age of 17 and he began working as a musician in Los Angeles to help support his family. He was a band leader until he could no longer play. His stage name was Slim Henry.

Henry and Joyce were married December 23, 1971 then moved to Las Vegas in 1973 and to the union they had one son and a step daughter.

Henry, Joyce and Jared joined Unity Baptist Church. Henry joined the Male Chorus where he played his base guitar and sometimes led a song.
