



Lawrence E Bennett

Lawrence Elbert Bennett was born in Willingboro, New Jersey on August 05, 1985, to Willie E. Bennett and the late Lena M. Bennett. From this union he was the youngest of three siblings. He received his early education in the public-school system, and then graduated from The Pennsylvania Leadership Charter High School (PALCS) in 2007. He later attended Full Sail University in Orlando, Florida where he studies Music Production for two years. In 2018, he received his Associate of Applied Science Degree in Audio Technology from SAE Institute in Atlanta, Georgia.

Lawrence (LB), also known as DJ Pusha, always had a love for music and at the young age of 16 he had his own music recording studio where he would produce aspiring local artists in the Willingboro area. Additionally, LB and a few of his close friends formed Starting Line-Up Entertainment where he was one of the first in the Tri-State area to start selling Mixtapes and DVDs at that time. DJ Pusha began Djaying with The Audio Trapping Mixtape (ATM) Crew in the mid-2000s, and was a DJ in Orlando, FL; Atlanta, GA; Philadelphia, PA; and Las Vegas, NV. In addition to being a producer and DJ, he also recently began artist management.

Lawrence was baptized in 2008 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church (Orlando, FL) in 2008.

In 2022, Lawrence followed in his father's footsteps and received his CDL Truck driver's License at 160 Driving Academy. He then began driving trucks for Taylor Trucking Company in Las Vegas, Nevada where he resided. He also continued Djaying and producing when he was not on the road.

On September 26, 2023, Lawrence died in a fatal car accident in Las Vegas, Nevada at the age of 38. We believe Lawrence received his wings that day as he loved the Lord. Lawrence was an outgoing, funny, charming, young man who was always full of life.

Lawrence was a beloved father of two young children who he loved dearly, a son, brother, uncle, cousin, and friend to many. He was truly loved and will be deeply missed.

Lawrence leaves to cherish his memory, his father Willie E. Bennett; his children Jordan Lamonte Bennett and Amari Faye Bennett; siblings from the union of his parents Erica L. Hines and Tia S. Bennett; siblings Elder Michael Bennett, Tyrone Green, Ramona Dixon, and Darren Gibson; a special cousin who was like a brother Michael Leonard and special aunt Carolyn Montgomery-Lovett; and a host of nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, extended family, and friends. Lawrence is preceded in death by his late mother Lena M. Bennett. Anyone who knew Lawrence knew how close he was to his mother.
