Robert was born on April 11, 1946, to Edwin Mansch and Helen Mansch in Sacramento, California. He was the youngest of three boys. After Robert graduated from Luther Burbank High School, he went on to the United States Air Force, serving a total of four years as a jet engine mechanic, and also served a tour in Vietnam.
